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Proem

One fact that probably no one can deny is that the question of whether another intelligent life form on the level of humans, or higher than us, has been here on Earth has been a subject of fascination and mockery for decades in the Anglo-Saxon society of the Western world.

So also in Sweden. The country that I know best myself.

In this paper, I want to show, from a local point of view, that there are variations in a global perspective. Which stands in stark contrast to the one-sided denial and consensus-seeking skepticism that one encounters. Yes, almost exclusively, in our official mainstream media and society today, even among several of those who are, or claim to be, the subject's foremost advocates.

The most common objections heard are:

- "If it were true, it would have already been reported, news of the times, we would have already known!"
- "There is no (scientific) evidence for it"
- "Why does this only happen in the USA?"
- The distances in the universe are too great to make it possible to travel here

While the issue among honest independent experts appears to be anecdotally proven many times over, even outside the borders of the United States, our population seems to be enchanted by a group of people who have managed to spread the above propaganda widely and very successfully.

The otherwise professional disinterest seems to some as incomprehensible and to others as difficult to investigate but nevertheless explainable. In my opinion, the above pattern fits perfectly by definition that we are in the midst of a paradigm shift.¹

On October 20, 2024, Citizens for Disclosure Sweden was launched.² as an independent national committee for American **New Paradigm Institute**³. Led by Danny Sheehan, who is known from Watergate, Iran-Contra, etc. and now for his legal representation of high-profile whistleblowers in our subject. The organization aims to promote increased transparency and awareness around the UAP / UFO phenomenon. By combining resources and expertise, CfD Sweden works to support research and debate around these important issues in Sweden, and strives to create an open platform for dialogue and cooperation in establishing an evidence-based truth on the matter.

I myself am one of the founders, also national coordinator for CfD Sweden, civil engineer MSc, event architect/disc jockey⁴ and in this context I am a Disclosure advocate, note that I do not call myself a ufologist or researcher, I can agree with skepticism.

This living writing is a review of what I currently find most relevant and personally interesting, to give a quick insight into the issue to those who are curious. Some highlights, as well as footnotes to continue with for those who are more interested.

I am skeptical that the “eternal ufology” that produces thousands of hours of podcasts and X/ Facebook/Reddit threads daily is of such great benefit to the population at large, but it becomes easy material only for the already “saved”. This writing has the ambition to offer something different, a way into the subject to quickly get an overview.

One objection many have is that UFO / UAP personalities are so-called *grifters*, i.e. only dedicated to the subject to sell books and lectures, you can make your own judgment about me and where I stand. But I have not earned a penny from this, on the contrary, it has cost me reputation and possibly reduced reach online.

What's the point of doing this? My thesis is that much of the suffering and problems we see in the world stem from the closed societies and national security state/intelligence agencies that I believe have influenced how and why this issue has been handled the way it has been, and that a popular insight into this particular issue is a concrete key that has the potential to unlock much that is evil in one fell swoop and change the world for the better. How this issue has been handled, and how the public's perception has, in my opinion, been manipulated, points to the fact that we do not really live in a free world yet.

What has happened in my environment, concerning people with special information, as well as my own personal experiences of incidents in our society related to this, I can tell you more about upon request. Some interviews are available on YouTube.⁵

And yes, in recent years I have repeatedly tried to gain a voice in Swedish politics and mass media, both mainstream and alternative, without the slightest luck.

We need to start a new Swedish debate

Around our planet, in countries as diverse as Brazil and Japan, an issue has recently emerged in decision-making assemblies and campaigns by committed citizens.

The Disclosure movement in the US is at the forefront of this. It fights for increased transparency around the UFO phenomenon. It demands that governments acknowledge and release information related to this subject, today also called UAP, *Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena*. In 2023, the movement gained a lot of momentum after new congressional hearings.⁷

Tim Burchett, a congressman from Tennessee, has become a prominent voice in the movement. He regularly receives questions from constituents about UFOs and calls for transparency. Senior politicians from both parties, such as former Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer and Republican Mike Rounds, have joined the cause with a bill co-sponsored by⁸, which shows the importance of the issue. Names such as Secretary of State Marco Rubio, Anna Paulina Luna, Eric Burlison, Kirsten Gillibrand and Eric Moskowitz have raised questions about the phenomenon and are working to increase transparency.

In the US, there is a divide between these and another faction, which is heavily sponsored by the military industry. Politicians like Mike Turner have made a name for themselves for actively preventing transparency⁹ and promote the status quo to keep the public at their current low level of knowledge. Sean Kirkpatrick and Mick West as seen in *Science World*¹⁰ recently considered by many who are familiar with the subject to have the same agenda. So also a significant part of the leadership of our local UFO Sweden (unofficial national organization).

In Sweden, the UFO issue seems to be a non-issue, but with a good number of enthusiasts who keep up to date on their own in mainly American alternative media. Is this a sign of health where we generally focus on more down-to-earth issues, or is it rather an ostrich behavior where we turn a blind eye to the unknown? An open debate can lead to insights that are crucial to our understanding of the universe around us. Instead of ignoring the issue, we should be curious and open to discussion. Let's follow Burchett & co's example and dare to ask the difficult questions.

At the beginning of the year, about ten high-profile advocates stood on stage together in Austin, Texas for the premiere of **The Age of Disclosure**^{11 12}, where 34 politicians and whistleblowers have joined forces in a documentary to demand that the subject be taken seriously. On November 21st, it will finally be released on Amazon Prime to a wider paying audience (and by the time you read this, it will probably be available on pirate sites for those who do that kind of thing).

In the last two years, twelve people around this circle have now sworn an oath and testified on honor in the American Congress to the authenticity of the UFO issue. How many from the other camp, which we blindly follow in the Swedish media, have done so? None. It is high time we take this issue seriously before we fall even further behind.

Is this the biggest news story in world history or an influence operation that has managed to fool so many senior officials? Is either acceptable to ignore?

The Pentagon's inability to account for its spending is another factor. For many years, the US Department of Defense has been unable to track billions in annual spending.¹³ This lack of transparency not only affects the American public but also has implications for us through NATO and the DCA agreement, where uncertainty around defense spending can undermine trust and cooperation between allied nations.

In the SVT series **Aliens - the battle for the aliens**¹⁴ which was broadcast in the fall of 2024 by Kalle Ström, two of the country's leading ufologists were pitted against each other. E. Thomas Persson¹⁵ and Clas Svahn have diametrically opposed attitudes to the hypothesis that extraterrestrials visit Earth. Persson accused Svahn of a cover-up and psychological influence operations directed against his own population. Despite this, there was no subsequent discussion in the media.

Let's start a new Swedish debate!

The Unwanted News

The novelty value of extraterrestrial life on Earth is not only great, according to countless scientists and philosophers, it is **the biggest news in world history**.

So big that it's hard to believe?

Imagine the effect of an official confirmation that we are not alone in the universe, and have been visited! It would change our understanding of humanity, our place in the cosmos and our relationships with each other. Yet it is as if this news is met with skepticism, as if it threatens to upset the stability we have built around our worldview. The loss of confidence our institutions risk if they were wrong..? Or what could the response be due to?

Despite the enormous news value that this information brings, it is clear from my own bitter experiences that both the media and society are unwilling to even slightly embrace this reality today.

The discovery of extraterrestrial life on Earth has enormous news value for several reasons:

1. Global impact

- Such a proper announcement would affect all of humanity, making it relevant to a wide audience. People around the world would be interested in understanding what it means for our existence and our place in the universe.

2. Scientific significance

- The news would revolutionize scientific disciplines such as astrobiology, astronomy and physics. Scientists who are currently firmly within consensus would gain new perspectives on the origin and evolution of life, which would lead to extensive research and new hypotheses.

3. Cultural and philosophical influence

- The discovery would challenge our fundamental beliefs about the unique position of humanity. This would lead to in-depth discussions about philosophy, religion and ethics, which would further increase the news value.

4. Media involvement

- Media would likely provide extensive coverage of the topic, including interviews with experts, analysis, and reports on the social and cultural consequences. This would create a continuous news cycle.

5. Political and military implications

- The discovery would also have significant political and military implications. Governments would have to deal with issues of security, diplomacy and potential threats from extraterrestrial life forms.

In short, the news value of the discovery of extraterrestrial life on Earth would be incalculable. It would not only change our understanding of life itself, but also affect every aspect of human existence, from science and philosophy to politics and culture. Such news would likely be the center of global attention for a long time to come.

It's about more than just news value; we're facing a **paradigm shift**. Recognizing extraterrestrial life would mean questioning many of our fundamental assumptions about science, religion, and human existence. How would our institutions respond? How would we deal with the existential questions that arise? This creates a sense of uncertainty that many seem to want to avoid.

But according to surveys in the US and globally, acceptance of aliens as a reality tends to be between 20 and 55%. In the Pew Research Centers¹⁶In a 2021 survey, 51% of participants expressed a belief that sightings made indicate aliens, a figure that has increased in line with more military reports and public discussion.

We must dare to ask ourselves: why do we continue to avoid? Instead of dismissing or ignoring these opportunities, we should embrace them and discuss them openly. It is time for us to stop being

reluctant and instead begin to explore the amazing potential of understanding our universe and our place in it. We must not lose ourselves in the fear of the unknown, but instead see it as an opportunity for growth and insight. Let's start an honest UFO debate in Sweden!

Unscientific demands for evidence due to stigma

It is remarkable how high the standards of proof are for UFO and extraterrestrial life research. While we live in an era where technological advances make it possible to explore space like never before, witnesses are being taken seriously, and knowledgeable investigators have presented a credible model for how the vast majority of physical evidence is handled by the world's most powerful military powers, skeptics and consensus continue to dismiss all forms of evidence that do not fit into their narrow framework.

The world-famous Peruvian mummies, or rather **Tridactyl**-team that works for their good memory, has recently launched a new website¹⁷. Here you will find scientific reports, data and information about a Mexican hearing – all presented on a nice and clear page. Despite this, it seems that many are still reluctant to take this evidence seriously.

I find it hard to understand the plausibility of so many of my friends getting articles and videos in their feeds claiming that the mummies are cakes or dolls. Those are previous isolated finds that were obviously fakes, but not these latest presented results. It raises questions about the motivations behind such clips and articles. Are these accusations a way to divert attention from the real discussion of evidence and research?

Here is a presentation from archaeologist Ed Casas¹⁸, influencers Jay Anderson¹⁹ and Jesse Michaels²⁰ has visited the site and reported, and the subject's possibly foremost journalist Ross Coulthart has recently done the same, although his report has not yet been broadcast.

A local example of a researcher contributing to this important issue is **Beatriz Villarroel**²¹, an astrophysicist who has done significant work in the study of extraterrestrial life. Her work has focused on analyzing anomalies in astronomical data, which has led to insights that question our current understanding of the existence of life in the universe. Villarroel has also been a strong voice in raising awareness of the importance of taking UFO sightings seriously and investigating them scientifically. Without shortcuts away from the subject through stigma and slang categories for the unknown. Her research results challenge the traditional stance and open doors to new possibilities and theories. The latest are now peer-reviewed and published in, for example, Nature, but the arXiv platform arbitrarily chose to refuse, so strong is the stigma.

The prevailing narrative claims that only scientific evidence according to the positivist method counts for knowing things, i.e. repeatable measurement data, but it doesn't have to be that way at all. A large part of society and scientists and women worship this method almost religiously, often without even being aware of it themselves. We can arrive at knowledge and know things according to other methods, we apply this daily in the legal system and our everyday lives regarding most things. We don't need positivist scientific evidence in general, if you think about it, there is a lot that we consider ourselves to know that we don't have as strict requirements for today already. Basically, this is a (meta)physical question really.

It is time that we start valuing the research that is being done and the evidence that is available, instead of dismissing it out of hand due to ridiculous influence operations. We need a more open dialogue about UFO and ET phenomena, where we can discuss and analyze evidence without letting prejudices control our understanding. Let's give these issues the serious treatment they deserve, let's start the Swedish debate.

South America's acceptance of the phenomenon

Beyond the smeared news of the mummies in Peru, South America is in a unique position when it comes to acceptance of the UFO phenomenon. With a rich history of sightings and reports, many countries in the region, especially Brazil, have become pioneers in the discussion of these events.

One of the most famous and best documented UFO cases is the one that occurred in **Varginha**, in 1996. Several sightings of a number of mysterious creatures were reported here, which attracted both local and international attention. The residents of Varginha testified to strange events, including sightings of an unknown object crash-landing in the area, as well as encounters with alien beings. This case has become symbolic of how the UFO phenomenon can affect an entire social structure and has contributed to increased curiosity and acceptance among the population. The mayor signs off on what happened in James Fox's documentary *Moment of Contact*.²² Now in December 2025, the documentary will be released in a new version with additional testimonies and confirmations from, among other things, high-ranking doctors.²³

Military policeman Marco Chereze died of illness after close contact with a dying creature he was taking to the hospital. His sister has been vilified for "attention seeking" when she was probably just seeking redress. His surviving closest colleague has been intimidated into silence. The surgeon and chief specialist who treated Chereze, Dr. Liliane T. de Almeida and Dr. José AC de Souza, were finally interviewed about the Varginha incident last year. They provided insight into the medical aspects of the case, discussed the alleged encounters and the health effects reported by witnesses. Their testimony contributed to a renewed interest in the Varginha incident.

In June 2022, during a **Senate hearing** in the country²⁴, the UFO phenomenon was discussed at the highest level. This was a historic event that demonstrated the growing acceptance of UFO issues in the political sphere. During the hearing, evidence and testimony from both civilian and military personnel were presented, further strengthening the legitimacy of these sightings. The fact that the Senate chose to address the subject demonstrates an openness to exploring the unknown, something that many other countries still hesitate to do. And in September 2025, another session took place²⁵.

This change in attitude is not just a local issue; it reflects a global trend where more people in their own chambers, beyond the defense/security policy of politics and the confidential workshop of news editorial offices, are beginning to question the traditional view of the UFO phenomenon. This is easily seen by watching the aforementioned SVT documentary *Aliens*. With increased acceptance and curiosity, we can expect more discussions and research on the subject, which may lead to new insights into our place in the universe.

It is high time that we in Sweden also start taking these questions seriously. Let us be inspired by the example of South America and open up for an honest and open debate about the UFO phenomenon. Maybe there is more out there than we have understood so far? We should not turn a blind eye to the unknown, but instead embrace the opportunity to learn more about our world and the universe.

Roswell's various explanations may provide historical credibility

The most famous UFO case is undoubtedly **Roswell**. It is also one of the best documented cases, which has become central to studies on the subject and a symbol of the phenomenon.

On July 8, 1947, Roswell Army Air Field's information officer Walter Haut issued a press release claiming that they had recovered a flying disc on a ranch near Roswell. This press release named Major Jesse Marcel, who was one of the first on the scene and responsible for the find. Later that day, a press conference was held at which General Roger Ramey presented the material as a weather balloon. Marcel was initially quoted as supporting the explanation, but in a 1978 interview (published in "The Roswell Incident", 1980) he claimed that it was a cover-up and that the material was "not of this world". Later witnesses (e.g. his son) supported this.

The press conference photos show Marcel with balloon material, and some UFO researchers interpret his facial expression as reluctant (subjective). Haut's "deathbed affidavit" (2002, accessed 2007) claims that he saw an "egg-shaped" craft and bodies, and that the weather balloon story was a cover-up. However, Haut lived until 2005 and denied earlier UFO rumors; the affidavit has been criticized as late and biased (he founded the Roswell UFO Museum).

Testimony (e.g. from Marcel, Haut) is central to UFO research, but official documents (USAF reports) instead pointed to Project Mogul (a secret balloon to track Soviet

nuclear weapons). About 20-30 witnesses (later interviewed) claimed unusual sightings, but official reports did not include them, due to secrecy surrounding Mogul.

The changed explanation failed to convince the majority of local witnesses, it is said. This discrepancy has led to a number of popular conspiracy theories and a continued fascination with the event. Examining the stories surrounding this case may be one of the easiest ways to shed light on the authenticity of the UFO subject and achieve personal enlightenment.

The first reporting of the incident thus came from the military itself, but it was the media, especially the Roswell Daily Record newspaper, that published the news of a flying saucer, which contributed to the initial uproar surrounding the case. The news spread globally, but was nipped in the bud by the continued evasive media handling that completely went along with the official narrative.

After many years in oblivion, the case was revived in 1978 and into the 1980s, and to this day it continues to arouse concern and speculation. Even though it has been over 75 years since it occurred, debate continues around the world about what actually happened.

Scientists and enthusiasts, including experts who **Don Schmitt**, have questioned these official accounts above and highlighted testimonies that point to something of non-terrestrial origin crashing. Many believe that there is a lack of transparency and that the official explanations do not provide a satisfactory picture of what really happened.

In this context, it is worth mentioning the newly established **Task Force on Declassification and Transparency**, led by Anna Paulina Luna in the United States, at the behest of House Oversight Committee Chairman James Comer. This task force aims to promote declassification of documents and increase transparency around important historical events, including issues related to the UAP. By ensuring that the public has access to information, we can potentially gain a better understanding of the case soon.

Instead of dismissing testimonies and evidence that do not fit into the consensus and official narrative, we should examine these issues with a critical eye. Roswell is an excellent case to study, for anyone who is curious about potentially the biggest news in world history, who is not afraid of the implications and open to the possibility that there is more to discover. It is time that we have an open and honest discussion about the UFO phenomenon, let's start a new Swedish debate!

Modern conFLIRmation

Is the UFO phenomenon just a historical issue? No, of course there are also a couple of notable cases that have gained recognition and recognition in more modern times during the 21st century.

In connection with the New York Times article **Glowing Auras and 'Black Money': The Pentagon's Mysterious UFO Program**²⁶ from Kean, Blumenthal, Cooper 2017 about the secret

UAP/UFO program AATIP as whistleblower who testified under oath Luis "Lue" Elizondo²⁷ was director over, Chris Mellon, former Deputy Secretary of Defense for Intelligence, also leaked three videos that captured the attention of both the media and the public: FLIR1 (2004), Gimbal, and GoFast (2015).

The Nimitz case, which occurred in November 2004, involved American pilots from the USS Nimitz who reported unidentified flying objects (UFOs) off San Diego. Commander David Fravor, a U.S. Navy F/A-18 Hornet pilot, also testified under oath.²⁸ that they observed an object, called "Tic Tac", which demonstrated an ability to accelerate and maneuver in ways that exceeded known technologies. The incident was documented by radar operators and captured on video, resulting in the famous **FLIR1**. The case has attracted considerable attention regarding UFO phenomena and the US military's handling of such sightings.

Gimbal shows an object floating in the air, moving at a speed that surpasses human technology. The pilot can be heard expressing surprise at the object's movements and how it spins in the air. The gimbal video also provides a clear view of the object's shape and movement.

GoFast moving rapidly over the ocean, which is captured by an F/A-18 Hornet. The video shows how the object appears to accelerate sharply and disappear from view, raising questions about its origin and technology. The pilot comments on the speed of the object and states that it is moving much faster than their own aircraft. Admiral Tim Gallaudet, has also testified under oath that he received a warning email with this video during an ongoing exercise when it occurred. The day after, this email was mysteriously deleted.

These films have become central to modern discussions of UAPs, contributing to increased awareness and interest in the phenomenon. They demonstrated actual sightings of unidentified objects by military personnel and led to demands for more transparency and investigations by the US government.

In June 2021, the US government published a report on UAPs, compiled by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI). The report acknowledged that some of the observed UAPs could not be explained and that they represent real phenomena. The report found that there were 144 observed incidents between 2004 and 2021, of which only one had a plausible explanation, leaving 143 incidents unexplained.

This report marked a significant increase in transparency around UAP issues, acknowledging that there are phenomena that cannot be explained by current scientific knowledge. It has contributed to increased acceptance and discussion of UAP in both the political and public spheres.

At the hearing on November 13, 2024, a frightening document about supranational military capabilities was introduced as part of a secret project **Immaculate Constellation**²⁹ made sure to systematically exclude

and analyze data from radar and photographs linked to UFO sightings to improve their own group's understanding and verification of these phenomena and their potential origins.

The ongoing **New Jersey**-drone wave³⁰ began on November 16, 2024 and is characterized by a series of reports of unidentified “drones” observed in several cities in the state, as well as in England, the coast of Denmark near Sweden as reported by Aftonbladet³¹, and more locations around the world. Residents and authorities reported drone activity, resulting in concern and speculation about the purpose behind these sightings. Local law enforcement agencies and the FBI launched investigations to determine the origin and intent of the “drones.” Despite extensive efforts to identify them, many of the sightings remained unclear. In the absence of explanations, the ET hypothesis, which suggests that the “drones” may be of extraterrestrial origin, has become one of the most plausible theories among knowledgeable skeptics and observers.

Most recently, on November 6, 2025, Landvetter Airport was closed for several hours after an intrusion by unknown drones. A month earlier, Kastrup and Gardermoen were affected in our neighboring countries. This is a phenomenon that affects us in our everyday lives now and is difficult to deny.

Sweden's own mystery

The Baltic Sea Anomaly, discovered by **Ocean X team**³² 2011, has fascinated researchers, explorers and enthusiasts worldwide. The mysterious structure, located on the seabed of the Baltic Sea, resembles a large platform with irregular shapes and has given rise to speculation about its origin and purpose. Many see it as Sweden's own Roswell, a mystery that raises questions about extraterrestrial life and technologies.

The Ocean X team, led by Swedish explorer Dennis Åsberg, has conducted several dives and surveys of the anomaly. These dives have been monitored by NATO ships, further raising questions and speculation about what really lies on the seabed. The fact that a military alliance is involved in the monitoring gives the impression that there may be more at stake than just a natural formation.

During their dives, the Ocean X team has uncovered interesting details, such as traces of what may be artificial structures and unknown materials. Despite these findings, much uncertainty remains, and the exact nature of the anomaly is still unclear. The official (dis)explanations have not been satisfactory, which has led to increased skepticism and a desire for more transparency. It is important that we continue to explore and investigate these mysteries.

The Baltic Sea Anomaly is not just a mystery to Sweden, but to the entire world. By delving deeper into this mysterious structure, we can potentially reveal more about our history and perhaps even our place in the universe. Cosmoconservatism

It can be human to become a little conservative when it comes to the big existential questions like our place in the universe.

The resistance to accepting discoveries related to space is not necessarily irrational; it may be an expression of an inherent or created collective cognitive conservatism, a natural tendency to cling to the comfortable and familiar over the unknown and challenging. However, this conservatism can easily be heightened, with artificial means of power through the media to hinder scientific progress, if it becomes too strong and prevents an objective assessment of the evidence. It is a fact that independent thinking within UFO/UAP, struggles against **cosmoconservatism** – an excessive reluctance to accept ideas that challenge established knowledge on the subject.

Thinking new, truly *independently* new, is a rare ability. It can, paradoxically, be most difficult for those who possess the most knowledge. We tend to think of geniuses as unique individuals who emerge spontaneously, but the truth is more complex. Sure, some are born with a higher cognitive capacity, a greater propensity for abstract thinking. Even the most gifted are easily limited by the social matrix they are shaped by throughout their lives – family, education, media and institutions. Even the most knowledgeable can get stuck in established patterns of thought, just as madmen can get stuck in their erroneous ones.

ChatGPT illustrates this perfectly; a revolutionary AI model that, despite its capabilities, sometimes falls into conservative response patterns, limited by the data it was trained on. According to researcher Eric Weinstein, AI is useless at cutting-edge expertise in narrow fields with less than about 200 scientific reports³⁶.

In a world flooded with information, it is crucial to base your decisions on a foundation of verifiable knowledge. Seeking support in facts, empirical evidence, and scientifically proven methods is not only important for making informed decisions, but also for navigating a

information landscape filled with misleading claims and distorted truths. The key lies in the ability to sift through **prejudice**, both our own and those of others. This requires a critical and self-reflective attitude, a willingness to question established truths and to actively seek out conflicting perspectives. By continually challenging our own assumptions and actively verifying the sources of information, we can build a more robust and reliable body of knowledge – a necessity for both individual decisions and collective progress.

Challenging habitual and commonly held incorrect thought patterns is an incredible strength in the long run. Being able to properly deprogram yourself – a process similar to leaving a cult – may then be necessary.

To regain **shoshin**³⁷, the beginner's mind, a term from Zen Buddhism, is essential for breaking free from the trap of a reluctance to accept ideas that challenge established knowledge. Perhaps the only path to truly groundbreaking innovation.

It is also a fight against the cognitive comfort that is reinforced in feedback loops within the increasingly influential 3rd, 4th and 5th estates, media, organizations/institutions, social groups, where conformist tendencies are rewarded and radical perspectives are often marginalized.

In China, they say they don't look at funded mass media because they know it's propaganda, but in the West in general, but Sweden in particular, we have an awakening to do. We have traditionally had an unusually high level of trust in the media internationally and in ourselves domestically.

The actors of power have become central to the social game, especially in an era of uncertainty after World War II. The human ability to project evil towards the deviant makes psychology the most important tool for analyzing social phenomena such as this one.

Although these forces do not always manifest as totalitarian, they can still affect the foundations of democracy. In today's ecosystem, where information is disseminated through social media and alternative channels, it is clear that the Swedish public is on the front lines.

The discussions that take place in groups like UFO-Sverige's leading Swedish group on Facebook called "**The Public Discusses**" (where the undersigned was the most active writer at the time I was excluded, because I was too questioning, or a rule violation as the official version is called), as well as in chat groups and newsrooms, reflect a complex reality where the concept of conspiracy theory, which some claim was reinforced in the 1960s by the CIA to discredit dissenters and dissenting opinions after the JFK assassination, in which they themselves had influence, continues to influence public discourse.

Frank Hoffman³⁸ introduces the concept of "**hybrid war**" in his analysis of modern conflicts, emphasizing how various actors, including the media and social platforms, play a crucial role in shaping opinion and conflict. His 2007 report highlights how these dynamics create a

"whole of society" approach, where the whole of society becomes involved in the fight for information and narrative.

In this context, journalists Matt Taibbi and Michael Schellenberger have become central figures through their reporting of "**Twitter Files**"³⁹. These revelations have highlighted how social media companies, particularly Twitter (now X), have acted as gatekeepers for information, raising questions about censorship and manipulation of public discourse. By reviewing internal documents, Taibbi and Schellenberger have shown how platforms have collaborated with governments and other institutions to control what is allowed to spread and what is silenced, especially around sensitive topics like COVID-19, vaccines, and conspiracy theories.

Meanwhile, Mark Zuckerberg, the founder of Meta (Facebook), has also come under fire for his handling of pandemic-related information. Following the pandemic, Zuckerberg has "dabbled" in his communications, initially supporting strict moderation of content related to the virus and vaccines, but later admitting that some of the measures taken were too strict. This has led to criticism from both sides of the debate: those who believe the platform did not do enough to stop disinformation and those who believe that freedom of expression was being violated.

Zuckerberg's shift in stance has highlighted a larger challenge for social media: how to balance the fight against misinformation with protecting free speech. This dilemma has become particularly clear in light of the revelations made by Taibbi and Schellenberger, which have sparked a debate about the accountability and transparency of tech companies. At a time when X, Alphabet, and Meta are all under scrutiny, it is clear that the handling of information and discussions around the pandemic has had far-reaching consequences for public discourse and trust in digital platforms.

The question of freedom of expression and responsibility in the digital space is central: What is freedom of expression without a platform? So-called **mass formation**⁴⁰ is not necessarily totalitarian or brainwashing, but it is not democracy either. I would describe it as a strange kind of group conservatism, which has certainly affected the UFO/UAP field as well.

Hidden higher power

It is no longer possible to deny that the UFO issue exists, such an attitude is frivolous or not insightful today. However, this seems to be the official political stance in Sweden. The space officials in our parties have educational issues as a focus and have given me the answer that they do not handle the subject or they refer it to the ÖB (the commander in chief). Difficult to get an answer from there.

Where are the most important decisions made that form the basis for the UFO issue being handled like a hot potato that no one in Sweden wants to tackle with tongs, from an official perspective, despite the progress of our close ally in the West? Where is the power on the subject and does the power of democracy reach there?

Let's break down how publicity and power interact. Being famous can sometimes feel more like a punishment than a reward, it's been said. Many celebrities have publicly expressed their desire for a more private life, where they can escape the constant intrusive scrutiny and pressure from the media and the public. This often overlooked reality shows that the disadvantages of being recognized and scrutinized can outweigh the potential benefits.

Not least because many people experience a tendency in the media today to focus entirely on the most visible power structures, such as the government and the Riksdag. Traditionally, there were more investigative journalists who went deeper than that.

Let us not forget that power and influence can come in many forms. There are undoubtedly individuals who seek or are granted power without the transparency that often comes with official positions. Those who operate through influence and control that are not visible to the public, with great opportunity to influence the world without being in the spotlight. Various organizations, lobby groups and intelligence agencies operate in the shadows, often with significant influence on society and politics. These groups can shape decisions and policies without us even being aware of their existence. They can often be more effective than their less-shy counterparts, because they operate without the pressure and scrutiny that comes with the light of publicity. In an age where transparency and accountability are essential, it is crucial that we also recognize and understand the role of hidden power in our world.

The highest civil servants and women also have the right to make secret decisions and classify documents and information, which are protected by secrecy laws. These typically include heads of state, heads of government, ministers of defense and foreign affairs, and heads of security services. These individuals form a cluster close to **military leadership**, without public transparency, and plays a crucial role in shaping the nation's broad policies. This cooperation is central to managing security issues and formulating strategies, including with other nations and within unions.

We could see an example of this when our latest election results and opinion polls meant a no to NATO which then became a yes, mainly because the Social Democrats quickly changed their analysis due to Russia.

I ask the AI what security rating the extraterrestrial presence had received and the answer was **the highest** "Based on the potential risks, extraterrestrial presence can be classified as higher than the hydrogen bomb, given its unpredictable consequences." There we probably have the answer to what lies behind the shady handling.

There are also supposed to be documents from Canada confirming this high classification, and their former Defense Minister Paul Hellyer has mentioned this in interviews.⁴¹

Decisions regarding UFO strategy in Sweden would likely involve a combination of **MUST** (Military Intelligence and Security Service), FOI (Defense Research Institute) and possibly also the (security) police and some of the relevant highest-ranking politicians. From the USA it is said that

Not even most presidents have been informed, so make a reservation that politicians in Sweden are involved. Probably the vast majority of those who in some context have answered that they don't know anything are honest and don't deal with the issue at all, precisely because that's the way it is.

America's then president **Harry S. Truman** believed to have received the Roswell incident on their desk, thought carefully and decided to cover it up. There are also official documents that the US and the Soviet Union communicated about UFOs during the Cold War, to avoid suspecting UFOs of being each other's technology. If we suspect the highest security clearance even in the West, then the whistleblowers who claim that the subject was placed in a program modeled after

The Manhattan nuclear weapons project is naturally also absolutely right about the gravity of the issue. They also say that those who worked on the issue sign an NDA (non-disclosure agreement) where chapter 37 section 794 mentions the death penalty for revealing secrets related to this.

There are of course a few more examples of the weight of the issue linked to power. For example, in the 1960s, the American UFO organization NICAP got the former CIA director **Dr. Richard L. Hillenkotter** as chairman.

The amazing research from PhD **Jensine Andresen**⁴² She sheds light on how hidden power structures and psychological operations influence society. She also examines the complex relationships of the UFO phenomenon to state control and manipulation, with a particular focus on organizations such as In-Q-Tel and Enigma Labs.

Countries with horror examples like North Korea and East Germany have built physical borders against foreign ideas, but it of course does not end there. David Grusch has testified under oath that there is a hidden far-reaching influence campaign from American intelligence services regarding UFO / UAP against their own population, I add that it has ultimately affected the entire (Western) world.

There is now a great deal that indicates in which layer of the power apparatus and how and why the issue is being handled as it is. There are now a lot of official sources to draw on for those who believe that everything is just rumors. In a time where we strive for openness and transparency, it is worrying that there are shadowy forces in our midst that are working to keep the truth at bay.

It is crucial that we as a society are aware of these dynamics. To truly understand the UFO issue and its implications, we must challenge the covert operations that influence our perception. We need an open dialogue and an honest examination of the evidence and testimony, without allowing ourselves to be influenced by external or internal agendas.

Let us not let the fear of the unknown hinder our curiosity. Instead, we should strive to uncover the truth behind the UFO phenomenon, no matter where it leads us. It is time to break the silence and make way for genuine exploration of this fascinating subject.

Psy-op-ception

Many in ufology are aware of the insights that prominent whistleblowers such as David Grusch and Luis Elizondo have shared regarding the broad psychological influence operation, which aims to make society avoid discussions of UFO issues.

Despite this, an overwhelming majority seem to have missed a crucial point: that there **is an aspect of this operation that directly affects ufology itself**, and that this is **poorly understood in the subject among interested parties**. It is noteworthy that this critical insight rarely receives the attention it deserves, suggesting that many either dismiss it or simply do not take in what he has expressed.

No one wants to be forced to realize that they have been deceived, it seems to be a deep-rooted fear in us that is difficult to overcome. But clarifying the question of what was meant above may be central to understanding the subject. Is it the classic ET hypothesis, with visits by aliens from other planets, or the modern more exotic interdimensional hypothesis that is disinformation? Or other alternative hypotheses? Or neither? One thing is certain, however, ufology is polarized into different camps today.

An idea from ufologist E Thomas Persson is that the internal psy-op within ufology is represented by **Jacques Vallee**. It is about diverting and planting thoughts that divert attention from more concrete evidence and the aliens themselves to more alluring, mysterious, or abstract hypotheses — ones that can captivate UFO enthusiasts as much as, or even more than, the so-called ET hypothesis. The prominent French ufologist has proposed alternative perspectives, including interdimensional theories and mysterious parallel worlds. By presenting the alien hypothesis as a simple and naive explanation compared to more complex phenomena, it becomes easier for intellectual seekers to dismiss it.

It is also suggested from various quarters that there is a strategy to mix terminology and concepts from **New Age**-movement to make the phenomenon more abstract and difficult to define, which can lead to a lack of critical analysis.

Misleading can also mean spreading and popularizing interpretations that present the issue as a **phenomenon complex** with several possible answers, without specifying any of them. Or highlighting cultural and psychological factors rather than actual phenomena.

What the above ideas have in common is that aliens are not enough. But then you forget the confirmed mysteries in our and our guests' consciousness, which opens up a universe of its own all on its own.

The front lines of consciousness in the battle for the technology of the mind

In addition to UFOs and UAPs offering an opportunity – or risk, depending on perspective – to think new things and expand our consciousness, the field also seems to include more concrete examples of

it. Here the technology has **Remote Viewing** (RV) has become a central point of discussion. With recent advances, especially after the 2022 Nobel Prize in Physics awarded for research into quantum entanglement⁴³, we have gained a deeper understanding of how consciousness and reality may be more interconnected than previously assumed. RV questions traditional materialism and opens doors to new perspectives.

A famous debate between scientists **Christof Koch and David Chalmers** on the nature of consciousness highlights the complex questions we face when trying to understand how mental processes affect our perception of reality. Christof Koch is a neuroscientist who focuses on identifying the biological and neurological foundations of consciousness, and he argues that consciousness can be understood through the study of brain activity and its relationship to perception. On the other hand, David Chalmers is a philosopher who highlights the "hard problems" of consciousness, meaning that there are aspects of consciousness that cannot be explained solely through neuroscientific perspectives. Chalmers suggests that consciousness may involve more fundamental questions about the nature of reality, which has opened up formal discussions about phenomena such as RV.

The debate between Koch and Chalmers has been going on for over 25 years, since Chalmers published his influential article "Facing Up to the Problem of Consciousness" in 1995. Over the years, the two researchers have explored the nature of consciousness from different perspectives.

Recently, Koch, who had previously been more skeptical of certain philosophical aspects of consciousness, has shown an increased openness to Chalmers' ideas and the more fundamental questions surrounding consciousness. This has led to an interesting dynamic in their debate, with Koch now increasingly acknowledging that there may be aspects of consciousness that go beyond purely neuroscientific explanations.

Several of the phenomena studied in UFO research include not only sightings of physical objects, but also reports of interactions with alien consciousness. An interesting example is the whistleblower **Jake Barber** testimonies of his experiences of contact with an extraterrestrial intelligence. His work with his company Skywatcher, where he documents and analyzes these interactions, through the technology called **psionic assist / psionics**, has attracted great interest. Barber's experiences provide unique insight into how these consciousnesses can communicate and influence our reality.

In light of the above, it is no longer as easy to automatically dismiss RV, the technology that thus enables individuals to perceive distant objects and events through mental processes, something that has also proven to be a fascinating link between human consciousness and the mysteries surrounding UFO phenomena.

RV was developed during the Cold War, originally funded by the US government, and involves trained individuals, known as "**remote viewers**", uses their senses to gather information about a specific location or event without being physically present. The technique has its roots in both psychological research and esoteric traditions, and has sparked interest in both

military and civilian research for its potential applications in intelligence and problem solving. Despite skeptical voices about its scientific basis, RV has continued to fascinate and inspire researchers and enthusiasts worldwide.

It is also worth mentioning **Dr. Hal Puthoff's** research and his work with RVs in the 1970s and 80s, which led to the founding of programs such as Stargate. In his book "Mind Reach" he explores how consciousness can extend beyond the traditional boundaries of time and space. In addition, the documentary "**Third Eye Spies**"⁴⁴, named after a book of the same name from **Russell Targ**, these phenomena by presenting an in-depth analysis of how RVs have been used to gather information about UFO sightings and other paranormal events. By presenting real-life examples and research findings, the documentary challenges our notions of what is possible and shows that there is more to our conscious experience than we usually acknowledge. Targ and his colleagues have worked to prove that psychic abilities are not just myths, but that they can be studied and understood scientifically.

Understanding RV and its connections to the UFO phenomenon could be crucial to exploring the hidden layers of consciousness and its technology. It raises questions about how we might interact with and understand the alien intelligences that may be influencing our world. The front lines of consciousness in this battle are not just about observing the unknown, but also about exploring the deeper dimensions of our own consciousness and its potential. By uniting these areas, we may one day be able to unravel the mysteries surrounding both the UFO phenomenon and our place in the universe.

In August 2025, it premiered for **Psi Games International**⁴⁵ in Charlottesville, Virginia, an Olympics for psychic abilities, they also had a speaker list with significant names in the field.

The difficulty of predicting enormous technological advances

One of the most common objections to the ET hypothesis is that the distances in the universe are too great for alien life forms to get here. But if you believe that today's human scientific level, with its great problems in explaining consciousness and unifying relativity and quaternary mechanics in a physical model, is close to omniscience about the nature of the universe, then you are probably sitting on far too high a horse. With a great chance of erroneous perceptions and insurmountable limitations as a result.

Before the Wright Brothers and early aviation pioneers demonstrated controlled flight in the early 1900s, it was hard for people to imagine that we could cross oceans in hours instead of weeks by boat. Many thought it was impossible due to the limitations of gravity, but technological breakthroughs changed that.

The holographic principle is a hypothesis in theoretical physics that proposes that spacetime is not fundamental, but rather an emergent property that can be described as a hologram.

This idea, originally proposed by physicists such as Gerard 't Hooft and Leonard Susskind, has roots in black holes and quantum gravity, and it challenges our understanding of reality by suggesting that what we experience as "spacetime" might be an illusion based on underlying quantum information.

Just as a 19th-century person could not dream of jet engines or supersonic speeds, perhaps our current understanding of spacetime as a fixed barrier is equally limited – if the holographic principle is correct, very advanced civilizations thousands or millions of years ahead could have discovered ways of moving through the cosmos that few of us can imagine today.

Many prominent scientists/researchers such as Albert Einstein, Max Plank, Erwin Schrödinger, Roger Penrose, Tom Campbell and David Bohm as well as Eastern mystics and a large number of philosophers and thinkers have proposed non-materialist explanatory models for the foundations of our universe.

The 2022 Nobel Prize in Physics went to Alain Aspect, John Clauser and Anton Zeilinger for their work on the phenomenon known as quantum entanglement. Particles have been shown to be able to influence each other directly regardless of physical distance. An incredibly strong argument for the ideas above.

Late in 2025, the Swedish-Norwegian professor of nanotechnology Maria Strømme released a notable research article close to the above ideas that should not be missed.⁴⁶

Institutional paradigm shift

New Paradigm Institute(NPI) was originally founded in 2004 with the aim of exploring and understanding complex questions concerning our existence and reality. From the beginning, the institute had a broad focus, but there was a particular emphasis on challenging traditional ways of thinking and norms in science and philosophy.

In 2023, the Institute underwent a significant restructuring and reorganization to focus more specifically on the UFO issue and its implications for humanity. This change came in response to the increasing interest and growing legitimacy surrounding UFO sightings and UAPs (Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena) in American society.

NPI was founded by **Daniel "Danny" Sheehan** and **Sara Nelson**, who have contributed their respective expertise in law, psychology and sociology to shape the institute's purpose. NPI serves as a platform for exploring and understanding the UFO phenomenon and its broader significance to humanity.

NPI strives to bring together researchers and interested parties to investigate the phenomenon from different perspectives, including scientific and cultural aspects. Through interdisciplinary research, which unites disciplines such as astrobiology and psychology, the institute aims to develop a

Through testimony and briefings, he has educated policymakers about the need. His goals include encouraging legislative action to require investigations and increase public awareness.

NPI plays a central role in the Disclosure movement through its focus on research and education. The institute works to increase government transparency and promote open dialogue about the UFO phenomenon. By engaging in community discussions and hosting events, NPI helps to change the cultural perception of UFO issues and influence both the public and policymakers.

Sheehan has had a distinguished legal career, with involvement in several high-profile cases that have had a profound impact on American jurisprudence and society. The truth, proven to be the most powerful weapon, will triumph when all is said and done. By joining our efforts and sharing our stories, together we can break through the barriers of uncertainty and fear, and ultimately reach a deeper understanding of our place in the universe.
